Line Up: 7:00AM

- All Parade traffic/participants must enter the parade from Old Folkstone Road (CVS & Food Lion intersection via NC Highway 210).
- Line-Up Check-In Point FOR ALL PARTICIPANTS will be just past Clay Hill Road.
- When You Arrive Check-In with Event Staff Member. There will be a table set up.
- PARADE PARTICIPANTS Park your vehicle as directed and wait for further instructions.
- DROP-OFFS You will be directed to drop off your riders and proceed to EXIT LEFT on Country Club Road or Sneads Ferry Road. Please be prepared to be in and out in less than 5 minutes.
- Your group will be escorted to your appropriate placement / position ONCE YOUR ENTIRE GROUP IS PRESENT.
